10 scholarships of \$250 are available for participants who are commuters and 5 scholarships of \$500 for participants staying at Clark Kerr Center for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Summer Institute in Reading at the University of California, Berkeley on July 23-28, 2006.

Scholarships will be awarded to educators who are educational leaders in California schools, districts, or counties with significant percentages of low-income students or who are preparing to become teacher educators/researchers in doctoral programs in California universities.

Applicants are requested to provide a brief description of their responsibilities and the educational contexts in which they work. These descriptions should be sent to [ucsir@lists.berkeley.edu](mailto:ucsir@lists.berkeley.edu). Scholarship requests will be processed and awarded on an ongoing basis. Failure to register for the Institute within 10 days of notification of the scholarship may result in the scholarship being awarded to another applicant.

Scholarships will be applied in one of two ways:

- 1) If paying by credit card, the scholarship will be credited back to the credit card once the entire balance of the tuition has been paid.
- 2) If paying by PO or check, the balance due will be equal to the tuition minus the scholarship.
